Fearless Creativity

Lady Gaga, who was born as Stefani Joanne Germanotta on March 28, 1983 in Yorkers, New York, showed a strong passion in music since she was a little. She used to sing along using her mini plastic tape recorder to Michael Jackson and Cyndi Lauper's hits. There was also a point in her childhood where she learned to screech performed by The Rolling Stones and The Beatles. By age four, she had taught herself to play piano by ear. When she was a teenager, she penned her first song and played in front of public for the first time during an open mic night at New York's Elton John. At the age of seventeen, she was one of twenty people in the world to gain early admission to the Clive Davis program at the Tisch School of the Arts at NYU, proving herself as a smart one.

Gaga's music career was started through a performance in the Lower East Side club scenes. There, she found herself among singers who wrote the same style of songs. Wanting to try something different and unique, she decided to do something provocative in the music scene by being an exhibitionist, theatrical performer.

When she was 19, Gaga signed a deal with Def Jam Records but was dropped three months later. Not she didn't let her premature disappointment overwhelm her. She worked on a way to build her fan base by performing her local shows. Eventually, her unlikable on-stage style sparked the interest of hitmaker producer Jimmy Fallon, who offered her a label and partnered her with them.

Eminem: Survivor, is an unofficial biography by Michael Heatley of one of music's anti-heroes. All those in awe of the formidable Marshall Mathers need to buy this ultimate celebration of the skill and grit of one man, with inspirational words and photographs.



HODDY GENIUS

His name Eminem. Hip-hop's Elvis is correct to a degree, but not really inaccurate. Certainly, Eminem was the first white rapper since the Beastie Boys to garner both sales and critical acclaim (but he impact exceeded this confining distinction). In many actual ways, Eminem was one of the greatest MCs of his generation – rapid, fast, delectable, and unpredictable, a mix of pulling off long-form narrative as he was releasing a withering asax – and thanks to his mentor Dr. Dre he used music to create: thick, muscular kope that kept the tempo and provided Emin's music context.

It was certainly a great deal of the controversy Eminem created (some through in how his violent tirades, often attributed to mother or his wife, intertwined with fights of misogyny) that appealed to listeners too young to absorb the message. Eminem rebounded on his hit albums, *The Slim Shady LP* and *The Marshall Mathers LP*. With his "My Name Is" (aka "The Real Slim Shady"), he said the gravest, but it was before some detractors acknowledged his depth, which part by singles like the mournful "Stan", written from the perspective of an obsessed fan.

Eminem capitalized on his toward momentum by crossing (and) the big screen with *8 Mile*, earning acclaim for his performance and an Oscar for the film's anthem "Lose Yourself". But a number of demons led him to shut himself in the seclusion of his Detroit, an instance that meant he is indeed empty without Emin, before he returned to his roots with *Relapse*.

"personally, I just think rap music is the best thing out there, period. If you look at my deck in my car radio, you're always going to find a hip-hop tape; that's all I buy, that's all I live, that's all I listen to, that's all I love."

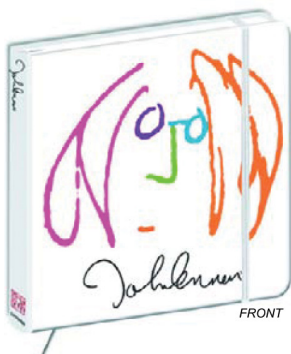

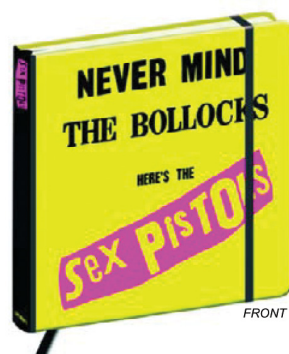
